Discuss the roles of the Area Delegate as well as the roles of the GSR; The never ending conference; Overview of the tasks of these service positions as broken down over the year month by month; Jan – Trustees decide final Agenda Topics for Conference; GSRs talk with group and set date (in March) for Agenda Topic sharing session; good time to plan for PRAASA

Feb – Delegates receive agenda topics (Feb 15th) and the area officers divide the topics to summarize; Goldie Locks division of summaries; takes one week; then will be translated; arrives to DCMC who passes on to GSRs no later than the end of month; Attend district's workshop on agenda topics; Attend PRASSA – general service on steroids; ask it basket is fun; Qs to stump the delegate especially. Make sure you're receiving CNCA Comments (or Comentarios) by now; if not, see the registrar. **March** – PRASSA event; facilitate group's sharing session to collect group conscience; plan ahead for Pre-Conference Assembly.

- Resolution on PRAASA *Pacific Regional AA Service Assembly (PRAASA) March 3rd to 5th2017
 - Dennis H presents; carried over from previous month/panel; usually DCMC does not put forth such items; PROPOSAL: In 2017, we would: 1) Fund two rooms one for men and one for women, for two nights (total cost \$440 to \$500); 2) Provide Scholarships of \$100 for 4 GSRs.
