Presentation on 71st Final Conference Report (Amy M.)

- 71st General Service Conference was held in April
- The printed final reports are not available yet, so only accessible as a PDF online right now
- Digital documents like the Final Conference Report have been sanitized so that an alcoholic's name is not full. Any full names that you see in the digital version are non-Alcoholics. Full names of both alcoholics and non-alcoholics appear in the print versions so ensure that they are not shared publicly.

Old Business

• That the District adopt the payment platform Stripe as a plugin on our existing WordPress-powered website (www.sfgeneralservice.org) in order

to accept online contributions from AA groups and AA members. The current pricing of Stripe per successful credit card charge is 2.9% + 30¢.

- We did a poll to see if folks felt ready to vote
 - Folks said they were ready to vote (96% vs 4%)
 - Simple majority won as the method of voting (71% vs. 29%)
 - Vote was 30 votes in favor, 0 against, and 3 abstain -- no minority opinion and this motion passed!
