## Tradition and Concept of the Month

- Tradition 3 (Gary B)
  - "The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop drinking."
  - Product of trial & error the early years were a bit exclusive in wanting "pure" alcoholics – no queers, crackpots, fallen women, criminals, or atheists.
  - Dr. Bob and Bill W. wrestled with the idea of keeping anyone from getting the help they needed – referenced the story of a man suffering from something "even worse" than alcoholism
  - AA has been able to spread across all demographics and across most countries now
  - There are also special meetings within AA (i.e. Young People, Women Only, etc.) but all are welcome in AA as long as they have a desire to stop drinking, even if AA isn't your "worst" problem.
- Concept 3 (Vanessa H)
  - "To insure effective leadership, we should endow each element of A.A.—the Conference, the General Service Board and its service corporations, staffs, committees, and executives—with a traditional 'Right of Decision'."
  - Mutual trust is key
